

COVID-19 Communications Update

Temporary Changes in Prior Authorization/Precertification for Skilled Nursing Facility (SNF) Admissions

Original notification: January 12, 2022

Zing Health understands that health care systems are experiencing increased demand and urgency due to the difficult circumstances created by COVID-19. For this reason, Zing Health is applying temporary measures to help members access care and reduce administrative burden for physicians and facilities.

For all states, Zing Health is temporarily applying the following changes to skilled nursing facility admissions from acute hospitals, effective through February 15, 2022:

- Initial precertification/prior authorization for admission from acute care hospitals to skilled nursing facilities (SNF) are waived for all Medicare Advantage (MA) Part C plans.
- The skilled nursing facility **will be required to notify Zing Health of admissions within 48 hours**. Providers may submit their request via fax. Providers can also submit their request by calling Zing Health directly by calling 1-844-946-4458.
- The post-acute care facility will also be **required to send medical records for concurrent review within three days** of the initial admission. Medical records can be sent to Zing Health by fax to 1-844-946-4458. Please include the patient's name and Member ID# on the cover sheet.
- Zing Health requires:
 - Hospital history and last two to three days of progress notes.
 - Any information that demonstrates a need for post-acute care.
 - Anticipated discharge plan with estimated length of stay.

This change does not apply to transfer between facilities or level of care changes within a SNF. In addition, Zing Health will continue to waive the three-day prior hospitalization requirements for skilled nursing facility stays as part of our normal course of business.

Long-term care hospital admissions (LTACH) and inpatient acute rehabilitation admissions still require a prior authorization for admission. If a prior authorization is not completed, the admission will be reviewed retrospectively at claims submission.

Temporary changes to reduce prior authorizations protocols for SNF admissions are effective through February 15, 2022.
